NOTIFICATION

First Aid Certificate is one of the requirements for appearing for any competency examination conducted by the Board of Mining Examination under the Coal Mines Regulations 1957 and the Metalliferous Mines Regulations 1961. At present First Aid certificates are being issued by the St. John Ambulance Association (India) and Multi Disciplinary Center on Safety, Health and Environment, Bhubaneswar. The Board of Mining Examination (Coal) in its meeting held on 17.06.2017 & and the Board of Mining Examinations (Metal) in its meeting on 20.06.2017 decided to invite applications from all organisations/institutes imparting training in First Aid maintaining the same standard as that of St. John Ambulance Association (India) and for issuing certificates to the candidates issued by them for the purpose of competency examinations conducted by the Board of Mining Examinations.

In view of the above, organization/institutes imparting training in First Aid with the same standard as that of St. John Ambulance Association (India) and issuing First Aid Certificates may apply within three months with relevant documents to consider recognition of their certificates for the purpose of competency examinations conducted by the Board of Mining Examinations.
