SUBJECT: Fatal accident occurred due to fall of person from height at Ashok Kumar H.S. Building Stone Quarry-2 (QL 928), situated in Sy. No. 59 of Hosahalli Village, Tumkur Taluk & District, Karnataka State (OC mine).



8. Brief Cause : "While a crew of seven persons were engaged in drilling operation at the top edge

of an opencast building stone mine, one person slipped and fell down to the bottom of the mine from a height of about 62m, inflicting serious bodily injuries, to which he

succumbed almost instantly."

- 10. Best Practices:
- 1. Install rigid barricading or guardrails at the edge of the mine wherever people work and Use anchor points and lifeline systems for fall arrest.
- 2. Designate danger zones at the top edge clearly marked and restricted and Conduct risk assessments before starting drilling operations near edges.
- Mandatory use of full body harness with double lanyard fall arrest system and Anchor the harness to a tested and certified anchorage point.
